# NDC GOALS WILL NOT BE MET WITHOUT COLLABORATIVE ACTION

1. NDC Partnership member countries are increasingly requesting support for designing and implementing climate actions at subnational levels;
2. Support is needed on the regulatory/policy frameworks to enact multi-level action for climate change, capacity development at national and subnational levels, and budgeting & investments to increase resilience and mitigate GHG emissions;
3. Vertical climate action has a strong focus on cross-sectoral activities. Considering sector-specific initiatives, waste, transport and water are the most cited sectors;
4. The evolution of the Partnership Plan implementation process will lead to increased engagement of subnational governments into the design and delivery of projects and actions.

# CHALLENGES AHEAD

- Regions are affected by climate change differently - the level of understanding of the NDC differs.
- Other regions that do not suffer visible environmental damages may not be aware of the NDC.
- Local governments face a scarcity of financial resources.
- There is a need for a coherent development strategy for the regions.
- Local authorities have difficulties accessing climate finance.
