Closing- We are all uniting for climate

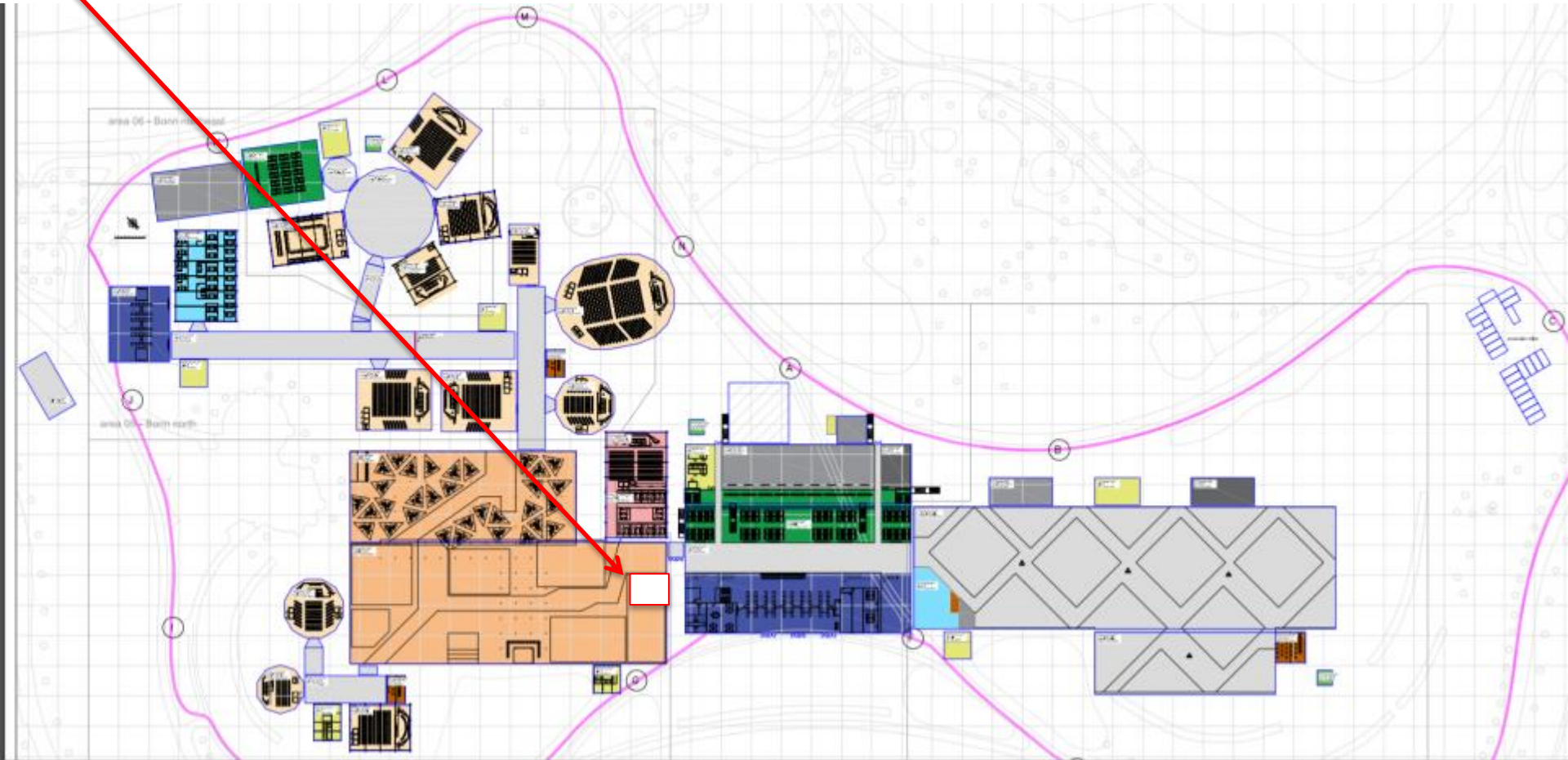
- Format of Session 1-4; Special Address + Panel/Roundtable + Initiatives

- Outcomes delivered to UNFCCC and Parties at the end and COP23 High Level Events



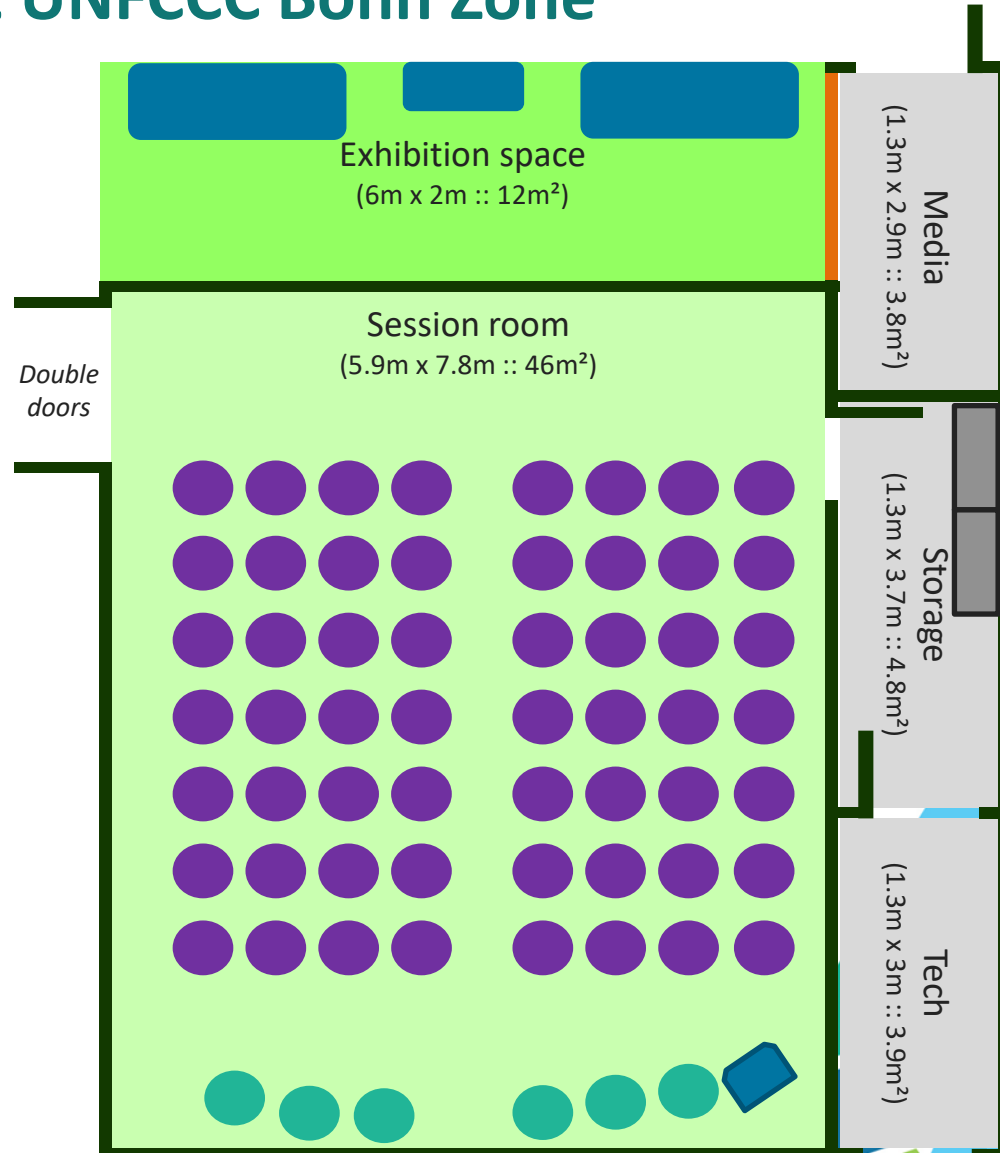
Cities and Regions Pavilion at UNFCCC Bonn Zone

- Tentative layout for 75 m²
