Identifying catalytic, innovative and more robust urban resilience projects is the central motivation behind the partnership between ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability and the Cities Alliance in support of the Transformative Action Program. The TAP is an initiative by networks of local and subnational governments to accelerate the implementation of local action to tackle climate change while advocating for enabling frameworks and appropriate support mechanisms. These projects are enhancing cities' ability to reduce exposure and vulnerability to multiple shocks and stresses through actions for climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction, and pro-poor urban development. This event will increase visibility and advocacy for local inclusive and resilience-building actions to nations and implementation partners.
